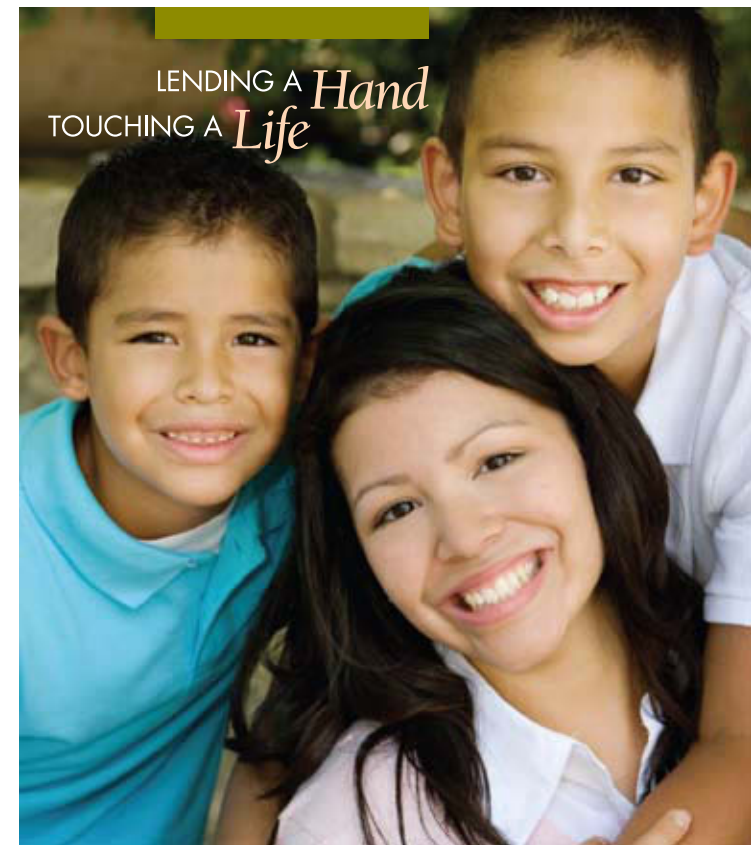

2010 Program Highlights & Outcomes

During the last fiscal year, CFCS served 1,230 children and family members from 104 communities across Massachusetts. Here are some specific highlights and outcomes from the personalized services that we provide.



Adoption Services—*Finding permanent homes for hard-to-place older children, sibling groups, and children of color referred by the Department of Children and Families.*

- 17 young people were placed in pre-adoptive homes with significant promise of permanency.
- Trained 85 potential adoptive parents to be able to adopt or provide foster homes in the future.
- 84 referrals for service—including child assessments, home studies and interstate compact placement contracts—were completed.
- 2 youth case managed by CFCS were legalized through adoption

Developmental Disabilities—*Providing personalized support services and temporary relief care designed to help individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.*

- 398 families from 38 communities caring for a family member with life-long developmental disabilities were supported through a wide range of direct and informative referral services.
- Created the Rainbow Group, the only support group in Massachusetts aimed at individuals with developmental disabilities who self-identify as gay or lesbian.
- Awarded two contracts by the Commonwealth to serve individuals with developmental disabilities, including Intensive Flexible Family Support—a new contract for CFCS.

Intensive Foster Care—*Providing transitional, therapeutic foster care for children coming from hospitals or residential treatment facilities in addition to general DCF referrals.*

- Served 40 children and adolescents, aged from 2-19, in our IFC homes.
- Successfully reunited 11 youth with their biological families.
- 45 families inquired about becoming a new foster care resource. Over 95% of these families were referred to CFCS by other foster parents.
- 10 new families were added to our program which is more than twice as many as were available last year.

Residential Services—*Offering transitional housing, as well as educational and career advocacy, enabling adolescents to move on to independent living.*

- Served 26 young adults, ages 16 to 22, in CFCS' three residential programs
- 79% were enrolled in an educational program
- 66% maintained employment
- Provided a variety of enrichment opportunities, including a four-day summer trip to Falmouth—the first time that any of these youth had been to Cape Cod.

Family Support and Stabilization—*Administering a variety of services in order to keep the family unit intact.*

- 130 individuals in 37 families were served to prevent the removal of children by the state or to reunify the family
- 35 families referred to community resources and services related to their child's healthy development have expressed optimism that the service would be of use.
- 96% of parents self-report that their children are happy, developmentally on-target or doing well in school.

Volunteer Mentoring Program—*Pairing volunteer mentors with at-risk teens and school-age children for guidance and support.*

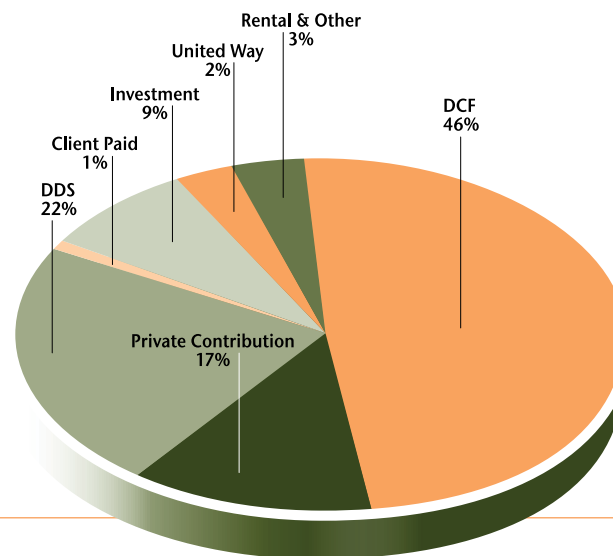
- 28 active mentor-mentee matches, including 11 new matches
- 59 individuals participated in the mentoring program this year
- 9 matches celebrated anniversaries of 1 year or more, including one match of 7 years!
